EXECUTIVE



Nurturing Progress in SEF 2 Programme


In a resounding testament to the success of the SEF 2 Programme, we joyously mark the completion of the first quarter, creating 3,000 work opportunities. A total gross wage of R5,315,994.04, encompassing UIF and COIDA contributions, was thoughtfully distributed among participants across three provinces. This financial infusion represents more than just wages; it signifies empowerment, transforming individual lives and communities.

The heartbeat of SEF resonates in the commendable community initiatives undertaken by our participants. A heartwarming example is the initiative led by sports coaches in Piketberg, rallying for a 16-year-old diagnosed with bone cancer. Through sports-related activities, they're not only raising funds for treatment but also fostering a sense of community and care.

SEF participants have embraced their roles as active citizens, responding to critical community needs. From supporting families grappling with various sorts of addictions, to numerous skills training programs such as plumbing, welding, spray painting, panel bitting, coding, e.t.c, SEF is not just a source of employment; it's a catalyst for positive change in the very fabric of our communities.

Thematic Areas Overview

Education

SEF fervently supported 139 schools, placing participants to benefit 60,075 learners. Innovative programmes like walking bus initiatives, reading clubs, and teacher/school assistants actively nurture a community culture of learning and support. The upskilling of participants in areas such as nursing, hospitality, and coding illustrates the program's dedication to enhancing skills.

Food and Nutrition Sustainability

Half of South Africa's population faces the challenge of living below the global poverty line. Through SEF, Thembalethu Development actively assists small farmers, providing solutions for nutritious food production. Initiatives like preparing land, planting seeds, and ongoing capacity-building workshops empower rural farm women. SEF also established community and school food gardens, maintaining 28 during September, contributing to community feeding schemes.

Waste Management and Environmental Stewardship

Identifying waste collection and recycling businesses, SEF assists in their development through training and support. To date, the amount of 35 tons of waste have been collected in the Western Cape, and Gauteng, and recycling 10 tons. The program also aims to establish hubs for waste collectors, enhancing their efficiency.

Health and Care Impact

SEF's health and care programme supported 15 healthcare facilities, conducting 1,841 home visits, providing mental health care to 9 beneficiaries, and placing 37 nurse assistants. The program actively engages communities, tracing 108 patients for medication adherence, reaching 150 people with TB awareness, and offering comprehensive healthcare services to 2,256 beneficiaries.
